It has come to my attention that the Asotin County Democratic Central Committee has habitually and willfully committed frequent and multiple violations of RCW 42.17A. Additionally, I have reason to believe that other

1) Failure to file accurate, timely C3 and C4 reports. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235)

violations of this chapter have occurred beyond what I have identified below.

State law requires that candidates and committees (unless they are mini-reporting) file frequent, accurate reports of contributions, expenditures, in-kind contributions, and debt. Unfortunately, the Asotin County Democratic Central Committee has failed to do this.

In December of 2016, the committee submitted a C1-pc and checked the "mini-reporting" option. Because they failed to file any C1-pc in January of 2017, this meant that they were required to engage in full reporting for 2017.

Prior to their most recent C1-pc, the committee failed to file any updated C1-pc since 2013. As such, they were required to engage in full reporting in 2014, 2015, 2016 (December excluded), and 2017.

Per WAC 390-16-115(4), because they failed to file a C1-pc between January 1 and January 31 from 2014-2017 indicating they would continue mini-reporting, they are legally obligated to file reports under RCW 42.17A.235 during that time period.

Despite this requirement, they have failed to file reports required by law. This is a serious violation of state law that must be rectified immediately. To cure this violation, they must immediately report any and all activity that occurred during the time period they did not qualify for mini-reporting.

2) Failure to update C1-pc. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.205(4))

On information and belief, the Asotin County Democratic Central Committee has failed on numerous occasions to update its C1-pc to include changes in officers and other information required to be included on their C1-pc, in violation of RCW 42.17A.205(4).

The PDC should investigate the possibility that Asotin County Democratic Central Committee committed the above violations maliciously, which would be a class C felony per RCW 42.17A.750 (2)(c). If the PDC determines that is the case, they should refer the case to the Attorney General's office for criminal prosecution immediately.
