Unfortunately, the payments paid do not necessarily correspond directly to particular invoices because it looks like the campaign paid even amounts as funds came in: \$8000 (plus a \$5 bank fee) was made on 8/9, an \$8000 payment (plus a \$5 bank fee) was made on 10/3 and a \$1000 payment was made on 11/1. These don't necessarily line up easily with the accrued expenses perfectly so some of these show partial payment applied to original expenses. This current C4 shows all of the outstandings to NWP, including some of the print work mentioned above:

Because of it, NWP may have applied their payments slightly differently than we did based on their own internal accounting system. But we show that we owe \$33508.06 which I do believe matches what they show we owe them.
