Dear Mr. Perkins:

We write to you today in response to the allegations in the complaint submitted by Glen Morgan on October 16, 2017. The complaint alleges that the 19th District Democrats have habitually and willfully committed frequent and multiple violations of RCW 42.17A. Please consider our responses during this initial review.

Noting the number of late filings for 2017: 58% were 1 day late, 75% 2 days or less and 92% 3 days or less. Also, all but 1 C3 and 1 C4 were for bank interest in the amounts of \$0.12 or \$0.13. 1 C3 and C4 included membership dues of \$210. It is inconceivable that any of these filings could be construed to be with malicious intent.

We strive to achieve complete compliance with all reporting requirements. It does seem to us that even the "valid" complaints concern minor matters and technical issues, as contrasted with intentional conduct designed to conceal pertinent information from voters. Nonetheless, we have taken the identification of these issues as a learning opportunity look forward to ensuring compliance with all RCW's, WAC's, and PDC interpretations in the future. We assert that none of the violations listed are of sufficient magnitude to warrant the criminal prosecution that Mr. Morgan is seeking.

#### 1) Failure to file accurate, timely C3 and C4 reports. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235)

State law requires that candidates and committees file frequent, accurate reports of contributions, expenditures, in-kind contributions, and debt. Unfortunately, the 19th LD Democrats have failed on numerous occasions to do this. (See Exhibits A - "Illegally late reported C3 and C4 reports")

It is important to note that in 2016, the Committee did not file a single C3 or C4 report until AFTER the election, despite being obligated to do full reporting. This is a very serious violation of state law.

Regarding the failure to file any reports in 2016, that matter was addressed in a letter to Jennifer Hansen at the PDC on Monday, January 9, 2017 (attached). All transactions have been identified and reported via ORCA C3's & C4's. Fiscal year 2016 reporting has been finalized with all financial documentation and ORCA reporting in agreement.

We acknowledge the claim regarding late filings of C3's & C4's. Line items 17, 19 & 28 were not filed on the Monday following the deposit of the received funds due to the fact that the filing requirement during campaigns was unknown by the treasurer at the time. All other late filings are due to lapses in attentiveness to the required filing date.

# 2) Failure to properly break down, describe expenses. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, see WAC 390-16-205, WAC 390-16-037)

Unaware of subvendor requirement. Have corrected C4's for 2016 & 2017 concerning payment for food for the 19th annual picnic on November 6, 2017.
