Willard W (Bill) McGregor, candidate for Port of Olympia, spent campaign funds on Facebook advertising in support of another candidate, Gigi McClure. This is in violation of RCW 42.17A.445 and WAC 390-16-238. Facebook does not allow two funding sources, split invoicing, or other methods of legally paying for an ad for two candidates. McGregor used campaign funds to pay for advertising for another candidate. Attached is one example of an ad placed by McGregor.

I may have cited the wrong regulations, but my understanding is campaigns aren't allowed to spend contributions towards other candidates, and joint ads must be paid 50/50. Please let me know if that isn't the relevant RCW or WAC.

Also, my experience in marketing and web design and development have lead me to understand that Facebook ads cannot have split payments. You can only hook it up to a single credit card or PayPal account.
