Enterprise Washington, a Washington corporation, is sponsoring political advertising that seeks to get the public to support lower state spending. These advertisements appear on their website, <a href="www.enterprisewashington.org">www.enterprisewashington.org</a> and <a href="www.budgetbreakdown.org">www.budgetbreakdown.org</a>. There were also paid advertisements during the 2025 Super Bowl, that can be accessed through the <a href="www.budgetbreakdown.org">www.budgetbreakdown.org</a> website.

These political advertisements do not mention specific legislation, but the intent is unambiguous: to encourage the public to oppose increases in state spending.

If, in fact, Enterprise Washington is reporting these expenditures to the PDC, then the advertisements need to contain Sponsor ID that can be tracked in the PDC database.

I believe the proper response to this complaint is to require Enterprise Washington to register as a Political Committee, and to file appropriately with the PDC on their donors and their expenditures.

#### What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?

The public is unable to see from either the political advertisements or on the PDC website the source, amount, or quantity details that are required to be filed with the PDC under the above statutes.
