Public Disclosure Commission Statement of Understanding WA Assn of Nurse Anesthetists PAC (WANA PAC) PDC Case 173514

I, Kelli Camp, in my capacity as the authorized representative of WA Assn of Nurse Anesthetists PAC (WANA PAC), hereby acknowledge that, during election year 2024, WANA PAC violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to timely submit C-4 reports disclosing election-related expenditures for the 2024 Primary and General Elections.

The facts are as follows:

- WANA PAC is registered with the PDC as a continuing political committee and selected the full reporting option. The PAC participated in the 2024 Primary and General Elections by making several contributions to candidates participating in those elections and participated in the 2025 Primary Election by making a \$1,200 contribution to candidate Michelle Caldier on 12/16/24 that was attributed to the 2025 Primary Election.
- WANA PAC was required to submit its 21-day pre-Primary C-4 report and 7-day pre-Primary C-4 report on July 15, 2024 and July 29, 2024, respectively. However, WANA PAC submitted a monthly C-4 report for July after the Primary election on August 9, 2024, which, as it was filed in lieu of the required 7- and 21-day reports, was 10/24 days late, respectively, and included information that should have been disclosed on those required reports. Late-reported election-related expenditures included a \$1,200 contribution made to candidate Janet St. Claire and a \$500 contribution to candidate Curtis King.
- WANA PAC was required to submit its 21-day pre-General C-4 report on October 15, 2024. However, WANA PAC submitted a monthly C-4 report for September 2024 on October 31, 2024, four days before the general election. This report was 16 days late and included information that should have been disclosed on its 21-day pre-General C-4. Late-reported election-related expenditures included a \$2,400 contribution made to candidate Patty Kuderer, a \$1,200 contribution to candidate Heather Koellen, and a \$1,200 contribution to candidate My-Linh Thai. Additionally, WANA PAC submitted a monthly C-4 report for October 2024 on November 5, 2024 (election day), which was 21 days late and included information that should also have been disclosed on a 21-day pre-General C-4. Late-reported election-related expenditures included three \$500 contributions made to candidates Liz Berry, Julia Reed, and Jessica Bateman, a \$1,000 contribution to candidate Terri Niles, and a \$1,200 contribution to candidate Joe Schmick.

- WANA PAC was required to submit its 7-day pre-General C-4 report on October 29, 2024. However, WANA PAC filed a monthly C-4 report for October 2024 on November 5, 2024 (election day), which was 7 days late and included information that should have been disclosed on a 7-day pre-General C-4. Late-reported election-related expenditures included a \$500 contribution made to candidate Tarra Simmons, and three \$1,200 contributions: two to candidate Dave Paul and one to candidate Marla Keethler.
- The late submission of the above-mentioned C-4 reports deprived the voting public of timely information regarding WANA PAC's election-related spending, specifically \$14,300 in contributions made to candidates, during a time-sensitive period in the election cycle.
- WANA PAC's monthly C-4 report for December 2024, disclosing \$12,400 in contributions made to candidates, was filed 33 days late. Late-reported election-related expenditures included one \$500 contribution to candidate Rebecca Saldana, three \$1,000 contributions to candidates Ron Muzzall, Paul Harris, and April Connors, and seven contributions of \$1,200 each to candidates Ed Orcutt, Michelle Caldier, Clyde Shavers, Tina Orwall, Brian Burnett, Keith Goehner, and Mike Steele. A \$500 contribution was also made to John Lovick for his 2026 campaign.

WANA PAC would like to avoid the time and expense of a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Brief Enforcement Hearing). Therefore, in lieu of a hearing, WANA PAC acknowledges that it violated Washington state law as described above and agrees to enter into this Statement of Understanding (SOU) to resolve the above matter with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC).

In accordance with the Penalty Schedule adopted by the Commission for Brief Enforcement Hearings set forth in WAC 390-37-143, WANA PAC agrees to pay a \$600 penalty (\$150 per late-filed C-4 report) for four acknowledged violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 for failing to timely disclose contributions and expenditures for July, September, October and December on C-4 reports during election year 2024.

WANA PAC understands that, by signing this SOU, it acknowledges the violations of Chapter 42.17A RCW set forth above and waives its right to a hearing in this matter. WANA PAC further understands that signing this SOU and returning it to the PDC with a payment for the \$600 civil penalty will resolve the issue of late reported contributions and expenditures for July, September, October and December of election year 2024 indicated above.
