<p>Bryantaylor09 reported via the portal <i>(Wed, 18 Jun 2025 at 9:44 PM)</i></p> <p>Multiple campaign yard signs for Pam Orebaugh, candidate for CVSD Board Position 5, are posted throughout Spokane Valley and Liberty Lake, and do not include the required sponsor identification (“Paid for by” statement and mailing address), as mandated by RCW 42.17A.320 and WAC 390-18-030. The signs were placed soon after candidate filing week in May 2025 and remain in violation as of June 18, 2025.</p> <p>I emailed the candidate on June 12, 2025, to inform her of the legal requirements and offer an opportunity to correct or remove the signs. As of June 18, there has been no response and no action taken.</p>
What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?
The lack of required sponsor identification undermines transparency in local elections and makes it harder for voters to identify who is behind the campaign. It prevents the public from evaluating the source of political messaging, which is especially important in nonpartisan school board races where campaign affiliations are not always clear. Allowing unmarked signage also creates an uneven playing field for candidates who follow the law.
