Subject: PDC Case 176255 TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117 WORKING FAMILIES PAC

Jennifer Shaw, TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117 WORKING FAMILIES PAC:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) completed its review of the complaint filed July 18, 2025 by Conner Edwards. The complaint alleged violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to timely disclose expenditures on Summary Expenditure (C-4) Reports.

Applicable Laws and Rules

- RCW 42.17A.235 describes the required filing deadlines for disclosure of campaign finance activities including monetary contributions.
- RCW 42.17A.240 describes the required contents of campaign finance reports filed with the Public Disclosure Commission.

Background and Findings

- TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117 WORKING FAMILIES PAC is a Continuing Committee, registered with the PDC under the Full Reporting option.
- TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117 WORKING FAMILIES PAC participated in the 2025 Primary Election, listing monetary contributions beginning in May 2025 to candidates registered as participating in the 2025 Primary Election.
- As a committee participating in the 2025 Primary Election, TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117 WORKING FAMILIES PAC was required to file a 21-day pre-primary C-4 on July 15, 2025 listing expenditures and contributions covering July 1 – July 14 and a 7-day pre-primary C-4 on July 29, 2025 listing expenditures and contributions covering July 15 – July 28.
- TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117 WORKING FAMILIES PAC filed two C-4s on July 28, 2025, including:
 - A C-4 listing expenditures made July 1 – July 14, 2025. This report was filed 14 days late.
 - A C-4 listing expenditures made from July 15 – July 28, 2025. This C-4 was filed timely.
- In June 2025, TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117 WORKING FAMILIES PAC completed a Statement of Understanding (SOU) and paid a \$150 civil penalty in accordance with WAC 390-37-143

(Brief Enforcement Penalty Schedule), acknowledging violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240.

Summary and Resolution

TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117 WORKING FAMILIES PAC completed a Statement of Understanding (SOU) and paid a \$300 civil penalty in accordance with WAC 390-37-143 (Brief Enforcement Penalty Schedule), acknowledging violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240 for failing to timely disclose expenditures on Summary Expenditure (C-4) Reports. The \$300 penalty assessed resolves the allegations listed in this case.
