Subject: PDC Case 176602 regarding PHYSICIANS EYEPAC - WASHINGTON ACADEMY OF PHYSICIANS & SURGEONS

PHYSICIANS EYEPAC:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) completed its review of the complaint filed July 16, 2025 by Conner Edwards. The complaint alleged violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to timely disclose expenditures on Summary Expenditure (C-4) Reports.

Applicable Laws and Rules

- RCW 42.17A.235 describes the required filing deadlines for disclosure of campaign finance activities including monetary contributions.
- RCW 42.17A.240 describes the required contents of campaign finance reports filed with the Public Disclosure Commission.

Background and Findings

- PHYSICIANS EYEPAC - WASHINGTON ACADEMY OF PHYSICIANS & SURGEONS (PAC) is a Continuing Committee, registered with the PDC under the Full Reporting option.
- The PAC participated in the 2025 Primary Election, listing monetary contributions beginning June 23, 2025 to registered candidates.
- As a PAC participating in the 2025 Primary Election, the PAC was required to file a 21-day pre-primary C-4 on July 15, 2025 listing expenditures and contributions covering July 1 – July 14.
- The PAC filed the 21-day pre-primary C-4 on July 24, 2025, nine days late.

Summary and Resolution

Based on our findings, staff has determined that, in this instance, any violation that may have occurred was minor and has been cured. After consideration of the circumstances, further proceedings would not serve the purposes of this chapter. Under WAC 390-37-060, the executive director, at any time prior to consideration by the commission, may dismiss a complaint which on its face, or as shown by investigation, provides reason to believe that a violation has occurred, but also shows that the respondent is in substantial compliance with the relevant statutes or rules, or shows that formal enforcement action is not warranted.

Pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(d), however, you are receiving a formal written warning concerning the failure to timely disclosure of all contribution and expenditures. PDC staff expects the PAC to timely file all future required reports of contributions and expenditures. The Commission will consider this formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action if there are future violations of PDC laws or rules.
