Re: Self Reporting for Vote Tyler Byrd re-election to Whatcom County Council, 2025

Dear PDC Officials,

Ayers Consulting LLC was retained by the Vote Tyler Byrd re-election campaign on April 13, 2025. The candidate conveyed to us that he had left over funds from his 2021 election campaign for the same office. He always intended to run for re-election and maintained email, websites, video, databases and other on-going campaign subscriptions expenses in anticipation of running for re-election in 2025.

His mother was his treasure for his 2021 council campaign. She moved to Idaho after the 2021 General Election and filed the campaigns last C4 on December 7, 2021, for November 2021. Candidate Byrd did not understand, at that time, that in order to use the remaining campaign funds for his re-election campaign he was required to register a C1 for re-election in 2022. In addition, continue to file C4's when his 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 re-elections subscription expenses reached the aggregated total threshold of \$750.

At the request of Vote Tyler Byrd we opened a re-election campaign in ORCA and set the beginning date as of January 1, 2022. We have entered all of the continuing expenses for the re-election campaign from January 1, 2022, to date. In addition, we have filed multiple C4 reports for each time period that the \$750 of expenses threshold was reached. There were no donations during this time period.

Vote Tyler Byrd understands that these disclosures/filings are late. We have tried to correctly disclose all of the re-election campaigns expenditure, as they would have been disclosed, had been filed on time.
