Hello Ms Mercier,

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to these complaints.

Concerning the status of the Shoreline Education Association as a "Sponsor" of the committee: we were anticipating donations from other organizations, and as they did not name themselves a sponsor, I did not update the reporting to identify them as such. Had more donations come in, I suppose we could have amended the form another time and removed them. In addition, there was carryover in the bank account which was greater than their contribution, dropping them well below the 80% in the complaint.

Concerning the robocall expense that is missing the vendor address: That was not this campaign. We did not run robocalls in this election, and as we filed final reporting in 2022, I don't believe I can or should re-file that C4.

Concerning the C4 that was missing the postage expenditure: agreed that that was an oversight. I did not realize it had not been captured until I was filing the next C4. I amended it prior to filing the subsequent one.

Concerning the lack of quantity on the postcards - that detail is missing, which I take responsibility for. But there were also no errors found by the system when I went to submit. That C4 has been amended with a note specifying the quantity ordered and mailed.

Concerning the lack of sponsor information on the yard signs: the photo shows signs from a previous campaign, before the sponsor information was required. Our understanding is that older signs were grandfathered in. The signs we purchased for this campaign are fully compliant and will replace the older signs.

Concerning the timing of the sign purchase: the purchase was made and entered into the system the same day (7/29). It will not show up, however, until the last C4 report.
