Complaint Description

<u>James Taylor</u> reported via the portal (Mon, 29 Sep 2025 at 7:38 AM)

Candidate **Erica Tomas (Auburn City Council, Pos. 4)** appears to be out of compliance with campaign finance rules. She has not filed the required **August C-4** under RCW 42.17A.235. Her **Facebook campaign page and posts** lack the required sponsor identification ("Paid for by..."), in violation of RCW 42.17A.320/WAC 390-18-010. She is **accepting contributions through Anedot** but has not reported any Anedot processing fees as expenditures, which is required under RCW 42.17A.240.

What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?

These violations directly undermine the public's right to transparency in elections. When required C-4 reports are missing, voters cannot see how a campaign is raising and spending money during critical periods of the election cycle. When sponsor disclaimers are omitted from social media pages and advertising, the public cannot tell who is funding and authorizing the campaign's communications. And when routine costs such as Anedot processing fees or obvious event expenses are not reported, it creates an incomplete and misleading picture of a candidate's financial activity. Collectively, these gaps hinder voters' ability to make fully informed decisions and erode confidence in the fairness of the election process.

Nature of Complaint

This complaint concerns multiple apparent violations of Washington's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A) by the campaign of **Erica Tomas**, who is seeking election to Auburn City Council, Position 4.

1. Failure to File August C-4 Report

- The Tomas campaign last reported expenditures on **July 28, 2025**.
- No C-4 report covering the period July 29 August 31, 2025 appears in the PDC system, despite the required filing deadline.
- Even if no expenditures occurred, a "no activity" C-4 was required.
- This omission leaves the public without financial transparency for the month of August.

2. Missing Sponsor Identification on Campaign Facebook & Instagram Pages (Exhibit A)

- The campaign's official Facebook page, "Erica Tomas for Auburn City Council," includes contact details, links to her website and donation page, but does **not state** who is responsible for the page or include a "Paid for by..." sponsor/treasurer disclosure.
- Under RCW 42.17A.320, a campaign's social media page is considered political advertising and must contain sponsor identification.
- The absence of sponsor attribution is non-compliant with PDC requirements.

3. Missing Sponsor Identification on Campaign Posts and Advertising (Exhibit B)

• On **September 19, 2025**, the Tomas campaign on Facebook and Instagram posted an event promotion for a "Meet Your Candidate" gathering at Les Gove Park, including a campaign graphic with her name, office sought, and call to action.

- Neither the post text nor the graphic contains the required "Paid for by..." disclosure.
- On September 28, 2025, the Tomas campaign posted a two-minute video on Instagram introducing herself as a candidate for Auburn City Council. The video and accompanying caption contain no sponsor identification or "Paid for by..." disclosure.
- These posts constitute political advertising without sponsor identification, in violation of RCW 42.17A.320 and WAC 390-18-010 / WAC 390-18-030.

4. Omission of Anedot Processing Fees

- The campaign solicits contributions through **Anedot** (secure.anedot.com/erica-for-auburn/campaign-fund), as listed on her Facebook page.
- However, no **Anedot processing fees** are disclosed in her C-4 filings.
- These fees are standard expenditures deducted from contributions and are required to be reported under RCW 42.17A.235.
- The absence of these expenditures indicates incomplete or inaccurate reporting.

Why This Matters

Transparency in campaign finance is essential to public trust. The issues outlined above: a missing monthly C-4, repeated lack of sponsor disclaimers, unreported Anedot processing fees, and discrepancies between campaign activity and reported expenditures, prevent voters from having a clear and accurate picture of this campaign's finances.

Requested Action




